



DECISION N° **18260285** MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of **09 JUN 2026**  
launching the competitive entrance examination into the first year of Bachelor Degree Programme in the Engineering Programme cycle at the Higher Institute of Agriculture, Wood, Water and Environment of the University of Bertoua, and specifying the number of places available for the 2026/2027 academic year.

Mindful of Decision n°1826039/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 17<sup>th</sup> February 2026 organizing the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and Institutions of Cameroon State Universities for the 2026-2027 academic year.

### DECIDES:

**Article 1:** (1) A competitive entrance examination for the recruitment of **two hundred and fifty (250) students into the first year of the Bachelor's degree programme in Engineering Sciences and the Engineering programme** at the Higher Institute of Agriculture, Wood, Water and Environment of the University of Bertoua, has been launched for the **2026/2027** academic year. The places are distributed as follows:

- **Two hundred (200)** students at the Belabo campus;
- **Fifty (50)** students at the Yokadouma campus.

The examination centres are as follows: **Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé.**

**Article 2:** (1) The fields of study open for the competitive entrance examination for the Belabo campus are as follows:

(3) Admitted students at the end of their second year of training will have to choose from the above-mentioned fields for the rest of their training.

**Article 3 :** (1) The competitive examination entrance is open in one session to Cameroonians and Foreigners of both sexes **without age limitation**.

**Article 4 :** If successful in the competitive entrance examination, candidates awaiting the results of the aforementioned official examination shall be admitted into the Higher Institute of Agriculture, Wood, Water and Environment of the University of Bertoua, at Belabo, only upon presentation of an testimonial of success or the result slips of the certificate obtained in 2026, and before the deadline set by the High Education Minister.

**Article 5 : (1)** The application file shall comprise the following:

- a- An online individual record form duly filled by the candidate on the entrance examination page of the school's website: <http://www.isabeeb.cm>;
- b- A photocopy of the National Identity Card;
- c- A certified true copy of the birth certificate (not more than 3 months old);
- d- Certified photocopies of the Probatoire or the GCE O/L, and the Baccalaureat or the GCE A/L Slips/Certificates;
- e- Certificate of non-conviction, bulletin no.3, issued not more than three months.
- f- Certified photocopy of the Baccalaureat or the GCE A/L, or any certificate recognized as equivalent to them by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, which must not be more than three (03) months old from the date of issue, or a certified photocopy of results slips of the Baccalaureat or the GCE:AL;
- g- A medical certificate of physical fitness issued by a State Medical Doctor;
- h- A self-addressed A4-size stamped (1500 francs CFA) envelope;
- i- A receipt of twenty thousand (20 000) FCFA, as examination fee;

(2) Application file must specify the Campus chosen by the applicant in the event of admission.

**Article 6 :** The application fee for the competition is **twenty thousand (20,000) CFA francs**. This fee must be paid exclusively into ISABEE's account at Société Générale Cameroun (SGC), account number 00600-05061384888-25, via **Express Union** transfer, against a receipt which must be included with the application. This fee is non-refundable. All other payment methods are excluded.

**Article 7 :** The complete application file shall reach either the Higher Institute of Agriculture, Wood, Water and Environment of the University of Bertoua, at Belabo, or the Regional Delegation of the Ministry of Secondary Education of the candidate's place of choice, **latest the 11<sup>th</sup> of September 2026 at 3:30 pm**. However, foreign candidates of countries in the CEMAC region shall deposit their files at the office of the Cameroonian diplomatic representatives of their respective countries.

**Article 8:** The written part of the entrance examination will take place on **Saturday 19th September 2026** in the following locations of the centres: **Bafoussam (Bafoussam Technical High School-Banengo), Bamenda (Regional Delegation of Secondary Education), Bertoua (Lycée Scientifique), Buea (Buea Bilingual High School Molyko), Douala (Lycée de Deido), Garoua (Lycée Classique et Moderne), Maroua (Collège de l'Espoir), Ngaoundéré (Lycée Classique et Moderne) and Yaoundé (Lycée Technique Commercial de Ngoa Ekelé).**

**Article 9 :** (1) The entrance examination shall comprise candidates' academic performance that will account for 25% of the assessment, and three written papers that will represent 75% of the assessment.

(2) Marks of file to study shall be determined by the candidate's Secondary and High School performances.

**Article 12:** The jury's composition mentioned in article 11, is specified by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, in conformity with the rules and regulations in force.

**Article 13:** The Rector of the University of Bertoua, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the Higher Institute of Agriculture, Wood, Water and Environment of the University of Bertoua at Belabo, each in his sphere, is responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French, wherever necessary.
